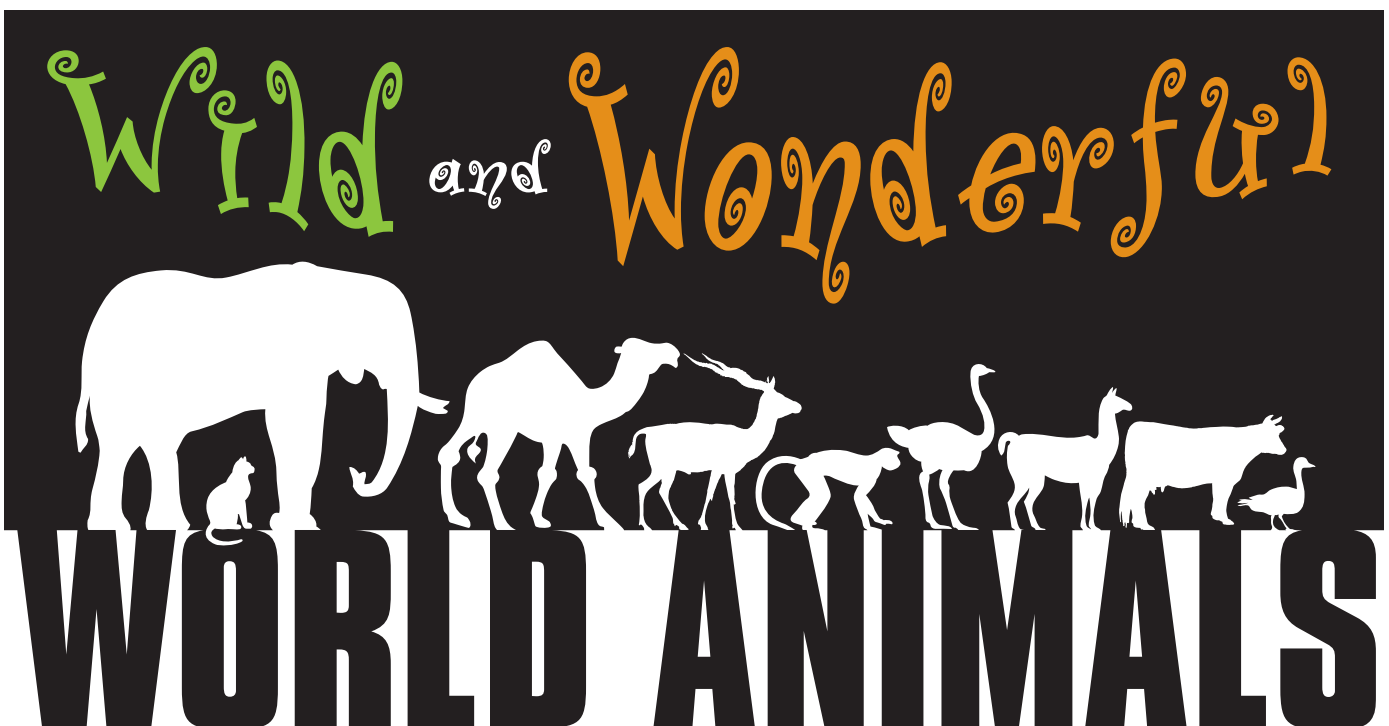

On a discovery mission you will go, searching for some of the most interesting animals on Earth. In the morning, you'll be challenged to find and create the MOST unusual! In the afternoon we'll head to Haviland's Cove Beach for swimming or to East Field Park for indoor play, if the weather is rainy.

Using cultural objects and art from Glens Falls' World Awareness Children's Museum, you will learn about animals and their meaning around the world. You'll also make masks, puppets, enjoy theatre games and create an animal folktale to perform on the last day of camp for your parents and friends.

From cows in India, to dragons in China and even goats in Romania, animals around the world have fascinating stories. Sheileen Nicholson, outreach educator for the World Awareness Children's Museum (WACM) and Johnna Maiorella, theater instructor at Adirondack Community College will be your instructors for this fun-filled program.

One group will meet with Sheileen at Explore! while a second group meets with Johnna at Lamkin's. We'll have a snack then switch groups. We'll eat lunch together and then ride Glens Falls Transit to Haviland's Cove Beach where WACM staff will supervise outdoor activities and the City of Glens Falls Recreation Department life guards will supervise swimming. If the weather is rainy, we will travel instead to the East Field Park for indoor games supervised by WACM staff.
