July 13-17 or August 10-14: Wild, Wonderful Animals Camp

Children entering Pre-K through Kindergarten

Get ready to learn about wild & wonderful animals from around the world! During this week-long day camp, campers will explore different countries, learn about the amazing animals who live there, and make an art project each day.

July 20-24: World Travelers Camp

Children entering 1st through 3rd Grade

Campers will travel the world and learn about different countries and cultures, create their own artistic masterpieces, and play games together! During this week-long day camp, children will begin to learn about how people live in different parts of the world.

July 27-31 or August 24-28: Messy Art Camp

Children entering 4th through 6th Grade

Campers will travel the world to learn about different artists, create beautiful messy art masterpieces, and learn how to work together with daily team challenges.

August 3-7: Mythical Creatures Camp

Children entering 1st through 6th Grade

Join us on an adventure through your imagination! We'll fly with unicorns, encounter dragons, and learn about other fantastic mythical creatures from all over the world!

August 17-21: Mission Earth Camp

Children entering 1st through 6th Grade

Your mission, should you choose to accept it, is to work with your outer space friends to make Earth a better place to live. Campers will explore countries around the world, make an art project each day, and learn about different ways to help residents of Earth!

General Information:

- Camp is from 10am-3pm, Monday through Friday, with optional before- and after-care available at an additional cost.
- Cost:
 - Museum Members: \$150/child per week
 - Not-yet-members: \$200/child per week
 - *Optional* Before-care (8am-10am): \$50/child per week
 - *Optional* After-care (3pm-5pm): \$50/child per week
- Daily camper and staff COVID-19 screenings
- According to NYS guidance for day camps, it is recommended that children wear face-coverings during camp, but not required. We leave it up to parental discretion as to whether or not your child will wear a face-covering during camp. All staff will wear face-coverings for the entirety of camp.
- Verification of immunizations and a health record must be submitted for each camper.
- Campers must bring food for snack time and lunch each day, and food must not require refrigeration.
- Each week is limited to a maximum of 10 campers.
- Cancellations may be made up to one week prior to your camp start date. If a cancellation is required, parents/guardians will be given the option to make a donation to the Museum or have a full refund issued to their method of payment. **WACM reserves the right to cancel any session.** In the event of a cancellation by WACM, you will receive a full refund. This cancellation policy is subject to change.
